Bullet Writing Basic Ground Rules - A bullet always starts with a dash (-) - Use internal punctuation as required - Never use ending punctuation in your bullet - Avoid using pronouns (he, she, his, her, etc.) - Minimize the use of the individual's name in bullets when it is elsewhere on the document

STEP 4: Fill out all the non-bullet blocks. Order/crosscheck the OPR notice, fill in each non-bullet 707 block, and watch for "gotchas." STEP 5: Write the 4 Duty Description bullets. Action word (A-5); Quantify; Scope--summarize all duties/additional duties in 4 hard-hitting bullets. STEP 6: Write the 4 YAGA lines.

BREAKING THE OPR CODE - Texas

The Air Force is transitioning to a new Two-Line Promotion Recommendation Form (PRF), for officers effective September 2019. This initiative impacting the Total Force was approved by the Secretary of the Air Force in April 2019 and will be implemented by the Air Reserve Component during the CY19 USAFR Colonel Promotion Board, convening 21 October 2019.
