Late 1833 Austin presented petitions for greater self government to Mexican President Antonio Lopez de Santa Ana. Santa Anna suspended the 1824 Mexican constitution and had Austin imprisoned for inciting revolution. After Santa Anna revoked local powers in Texas, several rebellions erupt and would be known as the Texas Revolution.
