Determine your family's gross monthly income. In order to receive food stamps in Pennsylvania, your family's income before taxes must be below 130 percent of the poverty line. That means that, as of Oct. 1, 2009, if you have

Gross income is the total, non-excluded income, before any deductions have been made. Net income is

the gross income minus your allowable deductions. If your household only consists of one person, then the gross monthly income to be eligible for SNAP is \$1,287 (net \$990). For two people, gross is \$1,726 (net \$1,335).
