Though Jesse Chisholm blazed the famous cattle trail that took his name, he never herded cattle. Rather, he used the path to transport goods from his trading posts.. Born in Tennessee in 1805 or 1806, Jesse was the oldest of three boys sired by a Scottish immigrant, Ignatius Chisholm and his Cherokee wife. Sometime later, his parents separated but both parents went to Arkansas Territory.

The trail was first marked by Jesse Chisholm in 1864 when he blazed the path for his wagons hauling supplies to his trading posts — one southwest of present-day Oklahoma City, and the other in Wichita, Kansas. Trading with the U.S. Army and the Indians, the trail stretched from southern Texas across the Red River to Abilene, Kansas.
